The following resolution was offered by Carl J. Gustafson
 Whereas the Electors at the last annual Township Meeting
 recommends that the Township Board be authorized to
 Erect and build a Town hall, where all public meetings
 could be held and that the expenses of building said
 Town hall, to be taken out of the contingent fund of
 the Township of Bates, and where as a petition, dated
 May 24th 1907 and signed by 53 Proprietors voted
 thereon asking that the Town hall to be erected in said
 Township, be erected at the forks of County Road running
 to Anassa and to Crystall Falls, that being on section
 21 Town 43 Range 34 West. That being the most convenient
 point for all parties, and where as said petition was
 filed in the Township Clerk's office, Now therefore be it
 resolved by the Township board of the Township of
 Bates the we cause said Town Hall to be built out
 of Money now in the Contingent fund and it was
 also resolved that we the Township board, secure
 a site for said Town hall on the above named place and
 it was moved by Gustafson and seconded by Borders that
 August Johnson appoint a committee of three to act as
 a building committee, and August Johnson therefore
 appointed the following named members of the board,
 Victor Benson, Carl J. Gustafson and Gotthard
 Anders to constitute the building committee. It was
 also resolved that said building committee be authorized

to buy a site and cause notices to be posted in three public places, and also to look after all things in touch with the building of said Town hall until the same is completed. Nothing more was coming before the board, we then on motion adjourned.

Township of Bates. July 5th 1907.

A meeting of the building committee was held on the fifth 5 day of July L. D. 1907 at 8 o'clock A. M. The committee met at the Forks of the County road going to Crystall Falls and Amasa, for the purpose of selecting a site for the Town hall, and it was decided to secure a site, to wit;— a parcel of land East of the Landerhof Road and 100 feet North then East to the Olson road about on $\frac{1}{4}$ of an acre and it was agreed between Oels Hanson and the above named committee that we pay the said Oels Hanson the sum of Twenty five Dollars for said parcel of land, and it was moved and supported that Victor Benson be appointed to secure a Deed for said parcel of land and it was also decided that the size of the Town Hall be 30x 64 feet with 10 foot studding. Nothing more was before the committee we then on motion adjourned.
