

Election Report

The annual Township ^{Meeting} was held at the School house on School district no 1 in the Township of Bates on the 2nd day of April 1894.

As soon as the inspectors of the Election was assembled, they appointed August Strans as a Chairman in place of Carl J Gustafson Supervisor who did not serve at the said Election Peter Sjogquist assistant Clerk, and Olof W Helgema Gate Keeper of the Election. The Board of Inspectors then consisted of the following Persons: August Strans Chairman Israel Carlson, Clerk Peter Sjogquist assistant Clerk, John E. Cronlund, and John Granberg Inspector, Olof W Helgema, Gate Keeper. After said Members of the Board had taken the Constitutional oath of office as prescribed by law, the polls was opened and continued open until five o'clock in the afternoon with the exception from 12 to 1 o'clock at which time the Board adjourned for one hour after having sealed up the ballot boxes as Required by law.

After closing the polls the votes were publicly counted by the Board of Inspectors and the result was Read by the Clerk of said Election to the persons there assembled and drew up the following Statement:

A Statement setting forth the whole number of votes given for each office, the names of the persons for whom such votes for each office were given, and the number of votes given for each person, that is to say; The whole number of votes given at said Township Meeting for the office of, Supervisors was Ninety nine (99) of which said votes Forty five votes were given for Carl J Gustafson, and Fifty three votes for Frank Erickson and one for Charles A Otto

The whole number of votes given for the office of Township Clerk, was Ninety nine, of which said votes Forty nine votes were given for Israel Carlson Fifty votes for Adolf Forsberg, The whole number of votes given for the office of Treasurer was,

Ninetyfive (95) of which said votes Fifty four votes were given for Erick Berg and Forty one votes For Gustaf Anderson.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Highway Commissioner was Ninety four of which said votes Fifty three votes were given for Edward = Sjogvist, and Fourly one votes for Adam Miller

The whole number of votes given for the office of overseer of Highways was Ninety three of which said votes Sixty one votes were given for John Lodergvist and Thirty two votes for Gust Nyquist

The whole number of votes given for the office of School Inspector was Eighty Seven of which said votes Forty nine votes were given for John Benson and Thirty four votes for John Att. and Four votes for Hervey Hall.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Justice of the peace to fill vacancy was Ninety one of which said votes Seventy two votes were given for Ole Benson and Eighteen votes for Olof Helgemo.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Justice of the peace for full terms was Eighty four of which said votes Forty one votes were given for Peter A. Carlsson and Thirty seven votes for Andrew S. Erickson and Six votes for Lavinias Hall.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Constable was one hundred and fifty four of which said votes Forty votes were given for John Straberg and Eighty one votes were given for Olof W. Helgemo and Thirty three votes for Victor Benson

The whole number of votes given for the office of Members board of Education was Eighty three of which said votes Eighty one votes was given for Peter A. Johnson and Two votes for Fay S. Clark.

The whole number of votes given for the office of Members of Board of Review was Eighty Six of which said votes Thirty five votes was given for
