

Proceedings of Town Board.

March 30th 1894

Pursuant to call by the Supervisor Adolph Forsberg a meeting of the township Board of the township of Bates was held at the Office of the Township Clerk on Tuesday March 30th A. D. 1894. the meeting was called to order by the Chairman, the roll was called and the following members were present

The minutes of the last meeting were read and on motion duly made and carried were approved as read

The Township Treasurer then presented his Books and Statements of all moneys received and Disbursed during the year by him as Treasurer and the same were checked up by the Board and found to be correct and on motion made by Peter Carlson seconded by August Krans the Statement of the different parties was excepted and Forsberg, Krans, Carlson Otto were none carried.

on motion duly made and carried the Clerk was instructed to record the Treasurer's Statement

The Board then proceeded to fix the Township Treasurer's and township Clerk's Bonds for the next ensuing year and the following Resolution was adopted

We the Township board of the Township of Bates do hereby order and determine that the amount of the Bond to be given by the Township Treasurer be placed at five thousand dollars (\$5000.00) and that the Clerk's Bond is hereby fixed at one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00) and that the number of

A motion was made by Chas Otto seconded
by August Krane to reject the Taxpayer
Ticket because the Committee had not
complied with the Law governing Caucuses
as Forsberg. Krane. Carlson. Otto. was now carried

The Board then went into a Committee
of the whole to examine the different Bills
brought before them for consideration
and on motion made by Peter Carlson
seconded by August Krane the following
Bills be allowed and the Clerk and
Chairman were instructed to draw orders
on the different funds in payment of
said Bills and that all Bills for snow
throwing and snow shoveling be disallow
ed
as Forsberg. Krane. Carlson. Otto
was now carried
