Know all men by these presents that we Olof Helgenro of the Township of Bates in County of Iron State of Michigan as principals and Nelson & Fisher and Peter J. Aronson, of the Village of Iron River, in said County and State, as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the Township of Bates, in the County of Iron, State of Michigan, in the penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars for the payment of which sum well and truly to be made in lawfull money of the United States of America, we jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, forever, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals, and dated this Ninth day of April A.D. 1903.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above named, Olof Helgenro shall faithfully discharge the duties of his office as Township Treasurer of the Township of Bates, in the County aforesaid and shall faithfully and truly account for and pay over according to law, all moneys which shall come into his hands as such Treasurer. Then the said obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
