

Township of Bates June 30th 1905.

A meeting of the Township Board of the Township of Bates was held at the office of the Township Clerk on the 30th day of June A.D. 1905. Meeting called to order by the Chairman. Clerk called the roll with the following members present: Charley Olson Supervisor, Israel Carlson Clerk, Peter Sjogquist and Emil Soderquist, Justices of the Peace. Minutes of Last meeting read and approved. Moved by Soderquist, seconded by Sjogquist that the Board instruct the Highway Commissioner to lay out a highway road according to petition and survey as follows: Starting at a point on Sunset Lake road where the section line between section 18-19 crosses said road thence to run east along the section line to the section of section 17-18, 19-20, in Town 43, North of Range 34 West.

The following resolution was offered by Carlson and its adoption was moved by Sjogquist and supported by Soderquist whereas it appears to this Board that a vacancy have occurred in the office of Justice of the Peace by removal of Benjamin Brockway from the Township therefore be it resolved by this Board that Clerk be instructed to notify the next succeeding officer, Gethor Nordin, to fill the vacancy in said office until another person is elected and qualified resolution unanimously adopted and carried.

The following resolution was offered by Sjogquist and its adoption was moved by Soderquist and supported by Carlson, whereas it appears to this Board that Mrs. George Sundgwill, a township charge of this Township have been paid a certain amount of money in cash each month during the last year, and whereas the Board thinks it will be more satisfactory to the people of this Township if Board supply their Poor with stuff to a certain amount in stead of cash therefore be it resolved that the Board

instruct the clerk to notify said Mrs George Sundqvist that she will get grocery to a certain amount hereafter in stead of cash at the store of Aronson & Russ. Roll called. Olson yes. Carlson yes. Sjogvist yes. Soderqvist yes. Board then went into committee for the purpose of auditing and allowing the following bills presented for consideration moved by Sjogvist and seconded by Soderqvist that the following bills be allowed and chairman and clerk be instructed to draw orders for the same as follows.
