The following is the minutes of a meeting held at the Twp Clerk's Office on the 4th Day of June A.D. 1906 meeting called to order by the Chairman Clerk called the roll with the following members present Charly Olson Supervisor
 Victor Benson Clerk Emil Soderquist August Johnson Justice of the Peace. Minutes of last meeting read and approved as read.

At said meeting Israel Carlson a guardian of Oskar Carlson who is afflicted with epileptic fits appeared before said Board praying that the Township Board would take steps to get said Oskar Carlson admitted to a Home for feeble minded and Epileptic Persons it was therefore moved by Soderquist supported by Johnson that Victor Benson be instructed to correspond with a substitute of this State provided for such Persons motion carried. A Bill was presented by Louis Olson for Damages to his fence along the Highway done in winter time on account of said Highway being drifted full of snow. an Order was by the Chairman and supported Johnson any or all bills presented before the Board for Damages or fences done during the winter time on account of the Highway being drifted full of snow will on and from this day not be considered as Damages nor be paid for out of any fund belonging to the Twp of Bates provided how ever that if any fences are not out side of the Highway Summer any or all such bills will not be considered. there for be it resolved that the foregoing Order will and shall take effect on or ~~from~~ from the 4th Day of June A.D. 1906 by Order of the Twp Board of Bates.
