

Township Meeting of April 9<sup>th</sup> 1907

The following are the minutes of a Township meeting held at the Clarke's Office on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1907. The meeting was called to order by the chairman with the following members present: Victor Benson, Supervisor, Israel Carlsson, Clerk, Gothard Nordine and August Johnson, Justice of the Peace. After the Officers had taken their Oaths of the different Officers they were elected to the Board proceeded to take up their usual business. The Clerk then read the minutes of last meeting which was upon motion approved. It was moved by Gothard Nordine and seconded by August Johnson that the Bonds of Township Treasurer and Township Clerk and Highway Commissioners be exempted. Moved by Johnson and supported by Carlsson that Lous Olson be appointed Health Officer. Carried. Moved and supported that 1.25 for a labor day be set and 4.00 for team labor be set for the ensuing year. Carried. The following resolution was offered by Benson: Where as Doctor Libby is in the habit of shutting up people as soon as there is a case of sickness and where as the Health Officer has ordered Groceries all over Iron River in excess of what was necessary therefore be it resolved by the Township Board of Bates Township that in case of sickness that Dr. McBurney be called upon as our Doctor and that the Health Officer is not authorized to order any Groceries before he gets order from Doctor McBurney to do so. Carried. It was moved by Johnson and seconded by Nordine the chairman appoint a -
