Twp the office of the ^{Deputy} ~~Township~~ ^{Clerk} having become vacant by Forsberg being quarantined it was moved by Nordin ^{and} seconded by Luqvist that we appoint Charley Olson ^{Deputy} Clerk for the unexpired term

A motion was duly made and seconded that the bill of Erick Berg for a Truck but through his Land and for Sunset Lake Road be paid for one half \$25⁰⁰ at this meeting and the other half \$25⁰⁰ in February 1909. All the members voting yeas for the above motion. Chairman declared Motion carried

A motion was made by Luqvist seconded by Nordin the two election tickets named Tax Payers Ticket and Taxpayers Tickets be exempted and to instruct the Clerk to cause said tickets to be printed

The above motion prevailed by all members voting yeas

A motion was made by Nordin seconded by Luqvist that we fix the Bonds for the Twp Clerk at \$1000⁰⁰ and the Bonds for Twp Treasurer at \$800. for the ensuing year All the members voting yeas Motion declared Carried

Township of Bates April 10th 1908

A meeting of the town board of Bates Township was held at the town hall in said township on Friday the 10th day of April 1908.

The meeting was called to order by Victor Benson chairman. The clerk called the roll and the following members was present Victor Benson Supervisor, Adolf Forsberg Township clerk Gothard Nordin and Aldo Lindquist Justices of the Peace.

Adolf Forsberg being duly Elected Township clerk at the annual township meeting (Election) presented his official bond which was duly approved and accepted. Edward Sjoquist Commissioner of Highways then presented his official bond which said bond was also duly approved and accepted. The board then proceeded to appoint a health officer for the ensuing year. August Krans and Frank Erikson being applicants for said office the board proceeded to ballot with the result that 3 ballots were cast in favor of August Krans and one ballot was cast in favor of Frank Erikson. August Krans being declared duly appointed. The following resolution was then offered by Adolf Forsberg who moved its adoption.

Whereas Oscar Erikson has qualified for the office of constable of Bates Township
