Township of Bates April 11th A.D. 1910

Pursuant to a call made by the
Supervisor a special meeting of the Township
Board of the Township of Bates was held in
The Townhall in said Township on Monday
the 11th day of April, 1910. The meeting
was called to order at 10 o'clock A.M.
by Victor Benson, Supervisor. The roll
was called and the following members
answered to their names Victor Benson
Supervisor August Johnson August Krens
Justices of Peace and Charley Olson Clerk
on motion duly made and seconded the reading
of the minutes of the previous meeting was
dispensed with. The Clerk then
presented his official bonds of \$1000.00

with Nelson & Fisher of Iron River and Olof Helgeson of Bates as sureties it was moved by Kraus and supported by Johnson that the Bonds given by Charley Olson be approved and accepted Motion duly carried

on motion duly made and supported the Bonds of the constables were fixed at \$500 each Motion carried by all the members voting yes The Board then took up the appointment of Health officers Charley Olson proposed the name of Andrew Hanson and Victor Benson proposed the name of James Laclair and as there was two candidates for the said office it was moved by Johnson and supported by Kraus that they proceed to elect a Health officer by ballot

Motion duly carried by all the members voting yes. The Result being 3 votes cast for Hanson and one for Laclair

on motion made by Olson and seconded by Kraus Andrew Hanson was declared duly elected Health officer for the ensuing year

This motion was duly carried by all the members voting yes

it was further moved by Kraus and seconded by Johnson that the Salary of the Health officer be fixed at \$25⁰⁰ a year Roll called on the above motion Benson yes Kraus yes Johnson yes Olson yes Motion carried

it was moved by Kraus and supported by Johnson that the wages for the highway commissioner be fixed at \$2⁵⁰ a day and \$2⁰⁰ a day for the overseer for actual service Motion carried by all the members voting yes

it was moved by Olson and supported by Johnson that highway labor be fixed at the following wages Team work \$4⁰⁰ a day and common labor \$2⁰⁰ per day Roll called on the above motion

 church meetings be refunded upon evidence
 that the Hall is put in good order and cleaned
 Roll called on the above motion Victor Benson yes
 August Johnson no August Kraus yes Charley Olson yes
 Motion Carried

Dec. Resolved that we the Township Board of Bates
 do hereby Authorize the Township Treasurer Olof Anderson
 to collect all charges for letting the Townhall
 to wit: \$ 8⁰⁰ for public shows and Dances
 \$ 3⁰⁰ for church meetings and Social meetings
 and furnish receipts to such parties as may apply
 for such purposes Resolution prevailed by all
 the members of the Board voting for the same

it was moved by August Johnson seconded
 by Kraus that the Frank Erickson Telephone in
 Nels Hansons Residence be discontinued for Township
 purposes and that the Township Phone be removed
 to the Residence of Mike Krick for which this
 Township agrees to pay one half of the Regular
 charges and Mike Krick to pay the other one half
 Roll called on the above motion Victor Benson yes
 August Johnson yes August Kraus yes

Charley Olson yes Motion duly Carried
 it was moved and supported to allow
 Mike Krick to place a Piano in the Town hall
 and to Rent the said Piano to such parties
 as have the Hall Rented if Desired provided
 however that the Township shall under no
 circumstances be responsible for Damage
 Breachage or Destruction of said Piano. Motion Carried
 by all the members of the Board voting yes
