

June 15th 1910

A special meeting of the Township Board of the Township of Bates was called to be held at the Town hall within the said Township on Wednesday June 15th A.D. 1910 ten o'clock in the forenoon meeting was called to order by Victor Benson Supervisor with the following members present Victor Benson Supervisor August Kross Justice of the Peace August Johnson Justice of the Peace and Charley Olson Township Clerk the minutes of the previous meeting was read by the clerk and on motion duly made and seconded ordered to stand as read.

The Committee on roads made their report as follows Gentlemen your Committee on roads beg leave to report as follows in looking over the several roads within this Township we find that the Laclair road can be sufficiently repaired by running the ore team grader over it for one day and it was decided the Chicago mine road be plowed and graded about 16 or 18 feet wide and also the sec. 22 road to be graded and straitened out in different places the Committee also recommends that the Charley Olson road be trimmed and the wagon ruts filled the right of way cleared sufficiently to let the sun in to dry off the road the Committee then visited the Sunset Lake road and found the same in a fair condition with the exception of some holes which need filling in on Saturday June 11th the committee visited the Demonga road and found that road impassable for travel upon investigation of said road the committee recommended that the Commissioners at once proceed to repair said road as to laying corduroys and putting the road in such condition that traveling can be done without danger to life and vehicles

and the committee recommends that the commissioners at once proceed to let contract to some suitable person to build a road west $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile or more as the case may be according to survey to the residence of Victor Demanga

A communication was then presented by Charley Olson from John F. Masow School Commissioner of Iron County regarding the coming school election and after discussing the same for some time the following resolution was presented by Charley Olson who moved its adoption supported by August Johnson

x whereas it has become necessary in this Township (by a change in the Laws of Michigan Section 117 Session Laws of 1909) to hold an annual election for the Town^{ship} School District of the Township of Bates on the second Monday in July for the year A.D. 1910 ^{and} every year thereafter for the purpose of electing School officers (Trustees) and for the transaction of such other business as may lawfully come before said meeting therefore be it resolved that we the Township Board of said Township of Bates do hereby order and direct that such a meeting be held on the 2nd Monday in July A.D. 1910 being the 11th day of July and on the second Monday in July every year hereafter as long as said Section 117 shall be in effect
