Meeting held on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Dec A. D. 1914

A regular meeting of the Bates Township Board was held Dec 4<sup>th</sup> 1914, at the township office at 2 o'clock P.M.

The minutes of the regular meeting held Nov 4<sup>th</sup> 1914 were read and approved as read

The Township Treasurer, M. B. Waitt, appeared before the board, requesting that this board authorize the said M. B. Waitt to secure a reliable Security or Surety Co to go on his bond as treasurer of Bates Township

After some discussion

The following resolution was offered by Hadstrom who moved its adoption

Resolved that we do hereby authorize the township treasurer, M. B. Waitt to secure one Surety Bonding Co. doing business in the State of Michigan to go on the said treasurer's bond

Resolution adopted unanimously  
The Clerk read a

A communication from the Crystal Falls Tax payers association requesting this board to send a delegate to Marquette as a protest against the proposed tonnage tax  
Communication ordered placed on file

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There was also read a communication from the Iron Co. Tax payers Association requesting that this board publish its proceedings in the future.

Clark ordered to have proceedings published.

The following resolution was offered by August Johnson who moved its adoption and was supported by C. A. Hidstrom.

Be it resolved that we furnish Mrs. Wm. Johnson with the necessary funds to take her to Hardwood Deckman Co. Mich.

Be it further resolved that the said Mrs. Wm. Johnson after such date of departing from Baker Township shall forfeit all her rights as to support and aid from said township what-so-ever.

Be it further resolved that we appoint one member of this board to make arrangements for her departure.

Roll called on the above resolution.

Resolution adopted unanimously.

Moved by Johnson supported by Coriebar that we appoint C. A. Hidstrom to make the necessary arrangements for the departure of Mrs. Wm. Johnson.

Motion carried unanimously.
