

PROCEEDINGS OF TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

A Meeting held on the 18th day of July A. D. 1914

A special meeting of the Township Board of the township of Bates was held at the Town Hall on the 18th day of July A. D. 1914

meeting was called to order by the chairman. the clerk called the roll with the following members being present Victor Benson John Coribear Al Hedstrom

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read

Moved by Hedstrom seconded by Coribear that Augt Johnson be allowed a seat on this board in power of his capacity as Justice of the Peace motion carried

A Resolution offered by Johnson who moved its adoption that we the Township board of Bates Township do hereby conform and agree that the Township is liable for one Mrs Antilla of the Regina Location as to the support of herself and children therefore be it resolved that we take the necessary steps to have the said Mrs Antilla deported from the U. S. of America to Finland her native home

motion seconded by Hedstrom

Vote on the said resolution was as follows
Benson (yes) Coribear (yes) Johnson (yes)
Hedstrom (yes) Resolution adopted.

a Meeting held on the 18th day of July A. D. 1914

moved by Hidstrom supported by Johnson that we buy a steamship ticket from P. J. Carronier who is the Co's authorized agent for the fare to Finland which amounts to \$109⁰⁰ also to allow her \$20³⁵ for clothing and the clerk be instructed to issue orders on the poor fund for the two Burt's motion carried

The board then went into a committee of the whole for the purpose of auditing the several bills which were presented to the board

and it was moved by Hidstrom supported by Johnson that we allow the bill as read with the exception of Mrs. Patenaude Bill for 70⁰⁰ for fumigators the clerk was instructed to inquire in regard to the bill.

a bill of A. Forsberg for Telephone Rental was also a subject of some discussion but was ordered paid the clerk and chairman then proceeded to draw orders for the several amounts

nothing further coming before the board on motion duly made and supported that we adjourn
