Mr P. A. Carlson spoke to the board in regards to <sup>the</sup> laying out of a Highway commencing at the south end of Lindholm's road running in a southerly direction for  $\frac{1}{2}$  a mile Town 43 North range 34 West

After some discussion a motion made by Johnson and supported by Hedstrom that we continue the Lindholm road for  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile or more if necessary and the damages to be settled in the future.
