

PROCEEDINGS OF TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

A Meeting held on the 24th day of March A. D. 1915

A meeting of the Township Board was held in the town hall on the 24th day of Mar. A. D. 1915. at 9 o'clock A.M.

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor the following members being present
Victor Benson, John Combs, Augt. Johnson
C. A. Hedstrom. W. B. Waite.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

The board proceeded to settle with the township treasurer and it was then found that the books of the treasurer was corresponding with the books Records and Accts of the township clerk and upon a motion duly made and supported, that we the Township Board of Bates find the Accts. of the treasurer W. B. Waite with the statements of receipts and disbursements during the year agree with the clerks accounts and said board accepts said statement in full settlement with said township treasurer. Motion carried unanimously.
Treasurers Bond

Moved by Johnson supported by Hedstrom that we fix the bond of the treasurer at \$10,000⁰⁰. motion carried unanimously.

Clerks Bond

Moved by Johnson supported by Hedstrom that we fix the clerks bond at \$1,000⁰⁰. motion carried unanimously.

The proceedings of the two primary elections were examined by the board and upon a motion made by Hedstrom and supported by Johnson that the clerk be instructed to make a copy of the two tickets and have 300 printed

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Upon a motion made and supported the clerk was instructed to have 150 Statement books printed
motion carried

The board proceeded to examine all the bills and upon a motion made by Johnson supported by Hedstrom the Putingint Fund Bills and Poor fund bills were ordered paid and the Highway Bills be laid over for further consideration
motion carried

A communication was received from Weidman & son Co. stating that through an error they had paid some mineral taxes in 46-36 on land not belonging to them and requested the board to refund the same which amounts to 12.⁵¹

Moved by Hedstrom supported by Johnson the we refund the amt. above stated to the said Weidman & son Co.
motion carried.
