

PROCEEDINGS OF TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

A Meeting held on the 29th day of July A. D. 1916

A regular meeting of the town board was held July 29th 1916.

All members being present.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved as read.

moved by Gustafson supported by Johnson that the road system of Bates township be divided into road districts, to be known as road district # 1 & 2, and that the road known as the Olson road should constitute the dividing line and said Olson road to be included in district # 1, and all roads east of said road, and all roads west of the Olson road to be known as district # 2

(motion prevailed)

The following resolution was offered by A. Johnson who moved its adoption

That whereas it as become necessary that the electors of Bates township will elect two overseers of highways of said township. And whereas the only season for building and improving highways is in the fore-part of the summer

And whereas it as become necessary to divide the several road roads within the township in-to two road districts.

It is hereby Resolved, that the Clerk will write out notices and have the same posted in public places according to law, that two overseers of highways shall be elected. Resolution adopted.

Moved by Johnson supported by Gustafson that the application of the Iron Range Light & Power Co. be laid on the table for further consideration
motion carried.

Moved & supported that the bills be allowed as read.
