

PROCEEDINGS OF TOWN BOARD MEETINGS

a Meeting held on the 10th day of August A. D. 1917

A special meeting of the township board of Bates was held at the Township Hall on the 10th day of August, 1917.

The meeting was called to order by the supervisor. The following members answered to roll; - Supervisor - Adolf Forsberg, Clerk - Jalme Johnson, Justices of the Peace - Mike Le Clair - Emil Thunander.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

It was moved by Le Clair and supported by Thunander, that the following resolution be adopted: Whereas, the Workmen's Compensation law of Michigan provides that each township in the state is subject to the provisions of said Act and that it is the duty of the township to make a record of all accidents occurring to the employes of the township; and to report all accidents to the Industrial Accident Board within ten days after they occur and thereafter in accordance with the rules of the Industrial Accident Board; and to pay employes of the township who are injured in the course of their employment, workmen's compensation in accordance with said law, and

Whereas, the law imposes upon the township board of the township of Bates, the duty of seeing that the said township complies with the requirements of the said Workmen's Compensation Law, therefore

Be it resolved, by the township board of the township of Bates, that the township clerk of said township, shall be and he is hereby appointed as the agent of this township board and of the said township of Bates, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Law; and it shall be

the duty of said township clerk in case of any accident to any employe of the township to immediately make a record of the said accident in accordance with the law in a book to be procured, by him for that purpose; and to report the occurrence of said accident to the Industrial Accident Board at Lansing, within ten days after such accident occurs; and thereafter to report said accident in compliance with the law and the rules of the Industrial Accident Board; and to pay the injured employe the compensation to which the law of the state entitles him on account of his injury, and

Be it further resolved, that said township clerk shall from time to time make a report to this board showing in detail, the accidents that have occurred to the employes of the townships; what action he has taken regarding such accidents; and the amount of compensation that becomes due to injured employes.
