A meeting of the Township Board of Bates was held in the Town Hall of Bates on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, A. D. 1917.

Meeting called to order by the Supervisor.

On roll call the following members answered to their names: Supervisor Charlie Olson, Clerk R. A. Putz, Justice of the Peace, C. J. Gustafson and Mike Le Clair.

Minutes of the previous meeting read by the Clerk.

Motion made by R. A. Putz, supported by C. J. Gustafson that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as read. Motion carried.

Motion made by Charlie Olson supported by C. J. Gustafson that the taxes of J. E. Greenland of five dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$5.38) be rebated to him, on account of being in very poor circumstances caused by excessive illness.

Motion carried unanimously.

Motion made by Putz, supported by Gustafson that the bill from the Monroe Iron Mining Company for explosives obtained by E. Bergquist be paid and charged against E. Bergquist and Roger Mine Road Contract.

Motion carried unanimously.

The following bills and pay roll were then examined by the Board:

Justice of the Peace, C. J. Gustafson and Supervisor, Charlie Olson, introduced the following resolution, which upon their motion was unanimously adopted,
