

May 7, 1926.

A special meeting of the Bates Twp. board was held May 7, 1926 with all members present.

Motion was made by Mitchell supported by Lindquist that T. Scott, Eugene Carey and Andrew Erickson be appointed as a committee to act with the township board in investigating lands suitable for park purposes.

At this meeting Mr. Scott, Mr. Carey, and Mr. Erickson met with the Township Board. Mr. Van Ornum of Iron River, Michigan met with the committee and board, and some land that he owns in Section 8 Twp. 43-34 was brought up for discussion. His price on 375 ft. of lake frontage and a ten acre tract was \$2500.00.

Mr. Erickson remarked that we should go to Sunset Lake and look over 3 or 4 parcels of land that are for sale. The supervisor set the date for looking over these parcels of land for Monday, May 10, 1926 at 8 o'clock a.m.
